Citizen Reminders

Temporary Signs

- Yard type signs and banner type signs are allowed and must follow these guidelines:
 - Must apply for a temporary sign permit in the Planning Department
 - Permit is good for 10 business days and up to 4 times per year.
 - Must be on your property and at least 5' back from the public right of way.
 - No "Offsite" advertising is allowed in the city limits.
- Why it Matters:
 - Regulating signs protects the appearance of the city, which helps with property values, and improves traffic safety.
