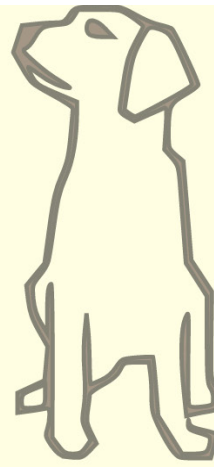
Conover City Park Splash Pad

Why it is so important to pick up after your animals? In short, it helps protect our rivers, streams, waterways, etc. One gram of dog fecal matter can contain up to 23 million fecal coliform bacteria that can cause diarrhea, cramping, and intestinal illness. When this waste is left on the ground, the rain can wash the waste into storm water sewers and carry it back to our beautiful water features. Even if you are not near a water source, it can be carried from the storm water runoff back to our streams and rivers! Not only is it being a responsible dog owner, but it is the law! Conover City Ordinances require that we keep our streets, sidewalks, and outdoor areas at home clean of pet waste. Help our community to stay healthy by remembering to carry doggie bags with you on walks or to scoop the poop in your backyard! Just one small step can help the community stay healthy!
