# LEAF COLLECTION UPDATES FOR THE 2022 SEASON



The City of Conover is excited to announce the City of Conover Sanitation Division now has 2 self-contained vacuum trucks (think automated) that will be collecting leaves throughout the City this year. With the difficulty acquiring temporary laborers as in past seasons, we believe this will be a positive change for our citizens.

The Xtreme vac debris collector is a one-person operation, meaning the operator stays inside the vehicle, making this a much safer way for collection by our employees.

With new equipment there will be a need for change on how leaves are placed for collection.

Beginning this leaf season, the back side of the leaf pile should be no more than 10 feet away from the edge of the street (this is the new collection zone). Anything left after initial collection should be raked to street edge for next collection cycle. Leaf season runs each year November through January.
